Where The Two Worlds (& Rivers) Meet

- Innocent Bystander 2006 Chardonnay, Yarra Valley, Australia 40
A perfect example of Burgundian Chablis meets Aussie Chardonnay. Lemon sorbet, dried mangos, fresh figs and white peaches on the nose lead to a palate layered with steely mineral notes and flavours of dried pineapple.
- Masi 2007 Tupungato Passo Doble Corvina/Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina 42
“Argentinian soil, Venitian style”. Passo Doble means two step in Spanish and is also a wine making term referring to the repressing of juice over the skins for extra extraction, colour, and tannin. This is a luscious wine with aromas of dark earth, rich dried fruits, warm spices coffee and chocolate.
- Tawse 2007 Sketches of Niagara Riesling, Niagara Peninsula VQA, Canada, 45
This excellent Canadian Riesling is crafted in the Mosel style of Germany, with moderate, off-dry sweetness, yet great balanced mouth watering freshness. Light bodied and silky, it’s brimming with peach and citrus notes.
- Tablas Creek 2006 Côtes de Tablas Rouge, Paso Robles, United States 60
Tablas Creek is the brain child of the Perrin Family of the Rhone Valley and American vintner Robert Hass. The Tablas Creek Vineyard Côtes de Tablas is a blend of four estate-grown Rhône varietals: Grenache, Syrah, Cunoise and Mourvedre. The wine features the fruitiness of Grenache balanced by the spice and structure of Syrah, with meaty, earthy notes from Mourvedre and Cunoise. Côtes de Tablas red blend is made in the style of a full-throttle Côtes du Rhone.
- Bokisch 2005 Tempranillo, Lodi, USA 62
This Tempranillo exhibits the varietal character of this noble Spanish grape along with a bold California winemaking style. It is luscious and round on the palate with delicate tannins and a soft finish. Black Currants and raspberry flavors combine beautifully with some clove spice. As in the traditional style of the great Spanish wines of Rioja, it is blended with a small amount of the highly prized grape Graciano.
- Tolaini 2004 Valdisanti, IGT Toscana, Italy 70
From Winnipeg entrepreneur Pierluigi Tolaini comes this super Tuscan blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Youthful, rich dark fruit, berry and cassis aromas meld with notable French oak spiciness. Valdisanti is full-bodied with deep but reserved fruit flavors framed by rich oak. A true expression of modern wine making from classic Tuscan Terroir.

Cakebread 2006 Chardonnay, Napa Valley, USA <i>Full and richly textured on the palate offering spiced baked apple, ripe pear and toasty vanilla notes.</i>	110
Charles Melton 2006 <i>Nine Popes</i> GSM, Barossa Valley, Australia <i>This blend of Grenache Shiraz and Mourvèdre is steeped in flavours of ripe dark fruit, and luxuriant mocha and vanilla notes.</i>	90

Talenti 2003 Brunello di Montalcino, Italy <i>Full-bodied, rich with powerful, ripe tannins, chocolatey, savoury black cherry & bramble fruit. Beautifully structured with crisp acidity, it is fantastic now and has great aging potential.</i>	120
Caymus 2006 Cabernet Sauvignon. Napa Valley, USA <i>Rich & bold with loads of black currant, plum and chocolate notes leading to a long smooth finish.</i>	125
Faust 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, USA <i>On the palate the wine is velvet-plush, smooth. Flavors are of ripe, fruit, with a hint of fresh rosemary. The quintessential Napa Cabernet.</i>	130
